Spokane Humane Society Offers Cat Spay and Neuter Discounts

This April 4^{th} – 6^{th} and 11^{th} – 13^{th} the Spokane Humane Society clinic will be offering discounted prices of just \$25 for cat spays and neuters. The discount is to encourage cat owners to "Beat the Heat" by having their felines fixed prior to their heat cycle to prevent unwanted litters from being born this spring.

Spring is just around the corner and area shelters including the Spokane Humane Society will quickly become overwhelmed with requests to take in unwanted pregnant cats and newborn kittens. "Female cats can have as many as three litters a year, and kittens can breed at as young as four months old," says Randi Oien, Director of Operations at the Spokane Humane Society. "While kittens are cute, there are simply too many unwanted cats and not enough homes," she continued.
